How can the EPA CHDV Grant program benefit our fleet? How do I know if I am an eligible applicant?

A: The program offers financial support for transitioning from ICE Class 6 and 7 vehicles to zero-emission alternatives, along with funding for infrastructure, workforce training, and development. Applications will be accepted only from states, municipalities, Indian Tribes, and nonprofit school transportation associations.
